Healthy Homes: Assessment and Interventions

During this new course, students will learn about the importance of conducting an assessment & resident interview using solutions-based approaches & tools. Likewise, after developing strategies for assessing the health-related hazards in a home, students will conduct an onsite inspection, from which they will develop a comprehensive action plan. They will learn about identifying responsible parties, estimating costs, handling the bid process, communicating with residents, managing quality control and keeping adequate records.
